3. Braille Circulating Library Celebration ❄️

March 27, 5:30 p.m.

The Braille Circulating Library of Richmond, Virginia celebrates its 100th year of operation in 2025. The Library provides Bible-based inspirational literature in accessible formats at no cost to individuals who are blind, vision-impaired, or print-disabled.

Seeing a need, Louise Harrison McCraw offered the first Braille books from a closet in her boarding house in Richmond, Virginia in 1925. As the library expanded, it moved into its current location at 2700 Stuart Ave in 1972. It has continued to grow and thrive, offering 1650 Braille titles and 2500 books and messages on cassette tapes, which are mailed to patrons across the United States and Canada.

The community is invited to help celebrate this milestone with an open house at The Branch Museum at 2501 Monument Avenue from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on **Thursday, March 27, 2025**. There will be live music, cupcakes, door prizes, and tactile games for the young and young at heart! Please stop in for a visit and learn more about this Richmond gem.
