1. New Men's Bible Study ✂

A New Men's Bible Study began last week and will meet on Tuesday evenings at 8:00 or Wednesday mornings at 6:30.

We are looking at Exodus, using the book *Exodus Old and New: A Biblical Theology of Redemption*, by Dr. L. Michael Morales. Dr. Morales is a professor at Greenville Seminary. In *Exodus Old and New*, Dr Morales examines the key elements of three major redemption movements in Scripture: the exodus out of Egypt, the second exodus foretold by the prophets, and the new exodus accomplished by Jesus Christ. We discover how the blood of a Passover lamb helps us grasp the significance of Jesus' death on the cross, how the Lord's defeat of Pharaoh foreshadowed Jesus' victory over Satan, how Israel's exodus out of Egypt unfolds the meaning of the resurrection, and much more.
